The congregation was founded in 1914 by the visionary zeal of Blessed Mother Mariam Thresia, a pioneer in the field of family apostolate, beatified on 9th April 2000. The founding of the college in 1964 under the able leadership of late Mother Josephine, the Superior General, was a memorable event in the history of the congregation. The college, which is an answer to the ever increasing demand for higher education among young ladies, was reaccredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) at 'A' Grade in the third cycle assessment in October 2013.
