






3 Research Projects, one being funded by U.G.C and the others by K.S.C.S.T.E. are taken up. Director, Dr. Aneesh E M, received the prestigious UGC research award. Colonies of three mosquito species which are the vectors of many deadly communicable diseases in Kerala were established. 11 research articles were published in peer reviewed international journals and 2 international citations were achieved. 5 new species of birds were reported for the first time in Kerala at Kole wetlands of Thrissur. 102 species of butterflies of high altitudes were reported & two of the species were in the IUCN red listed category and six were endemic to Western Ghats. Researchers presented papers in eight national and four international seminars. Mr. Sreedev Puthur won the best research paper award in National seminar – Biovision held at Mercy College. The laboratory has been functioning as a centre of consultancy and offers internship for students at U.G, P.G, M. Phil and Ph. D level. The laboratory has signed MoU with Vector Biology Research Laboratory, Mysore and Unibios India Ltd, Kochi. Two students completed their PG Project and Dissertation from this lab. National Science Day and World Environment Day were observed with various programmes.
