B.Sc. Degree of Calicut University with Chemistry/Industrial Chemistry/Polymer Chemistry (Main) or equivalent degree with Mathematics as one of its subsidiaries with at least 50% marks. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

Under Grade System: B.Sc. Degree of Calicut University with Chemistry/Industrial Chemistry/Polymer Chemistry (Core)with Mathematics as one of its subsidiaries or equivalent degree with Overall CGPA, at least equivalent to 50%. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

AIDED (Seats: 20)

Eligibility:

B.Sc. Degree in Mathematics or an equivalent degree with at least 50% marks or equivalent grade in Core and at least 50% marks or equivalent grade in Part III (Core and Complementary put together) OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.



Eligibility:

Any candidate who has passed B.Com or BBA (earlier BBS) degree of University of Calicut or B.Com, BBA, BBM or BBS degree of any other University or Institutes in any states recognised by UGC or AICTE with minimum of 45% marks or equivalent grade is eligible for admission. OBC and SC/ST students are eligible for mark/grade relaxation as per the University rules. In the case of B.Com (Honours) and B. Com (Professional) students, the minimum eligibility for admission is 50% for all categories of students.



M.Sc. Physics

SELF-FINANCING

(Seats: 10)

Eligibility:

B.Sc. Degree in Physics/Applied Physics (Core) of Calicut University or an equivalent degree, with Mathematics as compulsory complementary, having 50% mark or equivalent grade in Part III (Core and Complementary put together). In the case of applicants with triple main/three majors, they should have Physics and Mathematics as two mains/majors and should have minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade, while putting the three mains/majors together. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible for relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.



SELF-FINANCING (Seats: 12)

Eligibility:

B.Sc. Degree of Calicut University or equivalent/recognised degree with Zoology (Main) with (at least) 50% marks or equivalent grade in Core (Part III excluding subsidiaries). OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

Eligibility:

Bachelor degree in Botany or Plant Science of University of Calicut or equivalent qualification with a minimum of 50% marks in the main (core) subject under the mark system or equivalent grade under the grade system, with 45% marks or equivalent grade in the case of OBC/OEC candidates and with a pass in the case of SC/ST candidates.

Degree of Calicut University with Statistics/ Mathematics (Main) or equivalent degree with at least 70% marks for Part III (excluding subsidiaries). OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

Under Grade System:

B.A Degree of Calicut University with Economics/Foreign Trade/Development Economics (Main) or equivalent degree with Overall CGPA, at least equivalent to 50%, OR B.Sc. Degree of Calicut University with Statistics Mathematics (Main) or equivalent degree with equivalent grade to 70 %. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

(Computer Science or Information Technology or Electronics or Physics or Mathematics or Statistics or Chemistry) or BCA/ B.Voc in Software Technology/ B.Voc in Software Development of this University or an equivalent degree OR at least 55% of marks or equivalent grade in B.Tech/BE (Computer Science or Information Technology or Electronics or Electronics and Telecommunication or Electronics and Communication) recognized by this University. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.



IVI.SC. General Biotechnology

SELF-FINANCING

Eligibility:

Bachelor's degree under 10+2+3 pattern of education in Biotechnology, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Biophysics, BioInformatics, Genetics, Botany, Zoology, Life Science, MedicalLaboratory Technology, Chemistry, Physics, Environmental Science or 4-years Agricultural, Veterinary, Fishery Sciences, Pharmacy, Engineering/Technology(Biotech), B.Sc(Physician Assistant Course); ORMedicine(MBBS) OR B.D.S with atleast 55% marks or any other equivalent degree approved by the University.



Eligibility:

Candidates who have passed a Bachelor Degree course of this University or any other University recognized by this University as equivalent thereto and have secured a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade are eligible to apply. Professional graduates will be considered for admission provided they secure minimum of first class (60%) in overall subjects.

Eligibility:

Bachelor's Degree in any discipline recognised by the University of Calicut with a minimum of 50% marks. Bachelor's Degree includes other four year degree programmes like LLB, B. Tech also.

ENTRANCE BASED

Eligibility:

Candidates who have passed a Bachelor Degree course of this university or any other University recognized by this University as equivalent thereto with mathematics or statistics as Core or Complimentary subject and have secured a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade or BCA with mathematics up to plus two are eligible to apply.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. The eligibility conditions for applying various programmes and the method of calculating index marks will be at par with the norms of the University of Calicut.
- 2. The rank of the students who obtain the same index marks shall be, decided on the basis of the tie rules of University of Calicut .
- 3. While indexing marks for B.Com admission in the case of VHSE students, marks secured in the practical papers of Commerce, VHSE Management studies and Humanities shall be excluded. Only the marks secured in written theory papers excluding the subject offered in lieu of second language shall be considered for indexing purpose.
- 4. In the case of VHSE students for admission to B.A. Language and Literature Degree programme, the index marks shall be arrived at, excluding the marks of the vocational subjects of VHSE.
- 5. In the case of courses equivalent to Plus Two of Kerala HSE and have maximum marks or grades not in line with that of Plus Two of Kerala HSE, the same will be normalized to the maximum marks of Plus Two of Kerala HSE and the rank list will be prepared.

Conditions for NSS/NCC Bonus marks:

- In respect of NCC applicant the bonus marks will be awarded on the basis of NCC certificates signed by the Director, issued by the Directorate of NCC to the candidates who have secured at least 75% of attendance after having participated in its activities during the course of study immediately preceding the course for which admission is sought.
- The basis for awarding bonus marks to the NSS volunteers will be the certificate signed by the director, issued by the Directorate of NSS.
- The benefit of bonus marks for the purpose of admission can be availed by the candidates only under any one category, either NSS or NCC.
- Additional weightage marks will be given only in case of those NCC certificate on the basis of which no grace marks have already been awarded Important:
- Ten(10) Marks shall be deducted for every successive attempt after first attempt, out of the raking points to those who have taken two or more chances to complete the qualifying examination, subject to a maximum of 25 marks.
- The number of chances means the number of chances taken for passing any part or parts of the qualifying examination.

 Betterment of examination will not be considered as a chance.
