INTRODUCTION

Project Glowe by 2nd P.G English language and literature is a student minor project funded by CHF Management, fervently chasing after the golden snitch ‘English for Empowerment’ whose proud ownership is forever attributed to the Post Graduate and Research department of English, St Joseph’s College (Autonomous) Irinjalakuda. As a group of linguistically live and practically oriented women of right reasoning, we share our gift of language proficiency with participants. Glowe is lit from the spark initiated by Divya Jobi, Febina Mary Jacob, Mariyam Sandra Francis, Annet Jimmy, Grace Philip, Anat Varghese, Divya Joseph, Sirin Ashraf, Namidha Suresh A, and Juliet Joju. Our collective efforts reaped rave reviews and radiance thanks to Dr. Asha Thomas, our mentor, guiding us from Day one, to the present, with immense enthusiasm and a keen eye for detailing to make everything look seamless.

What glittered in our kindred community was the vision to empower our participants with quality training. We encrypted our skills into five activities— Language Guide, E4, Tedspeak, Me Magazine, and Web pals. Language Guide is a simple yet powerful programme formulated for those who envision a deeper grip on English grammar and vocabulary. E 4 is a specialized training to improve the listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills in English. Tedspeak focuses on developing the public speaking skills of students under training through a series of well-guided coaching to develop and voice ideas with confidence. *Me magazine* is an anthology by student authors. Web pals is a website that endeavours to bring out the creative ideas in literature and life, an inspiring agent for empowering, encouraging, and enriching women.

On 12th August 2021, Project *Glowe* ignited hopes, attracting official attention. The auspicious event held online was inaugurated by Dr. Radha P.S (Rtd. Faculty). The event also witnessed the launch of the website *Webpals*. Mr. Ram Menon, director of PRCI YCC, Kerala graced the occasion. In the ensuing sessions of online training, we trained 34 participants. *Me Magazine* featuring 22 authors was released on 24th March 2022 by Principal Dr. Sr. Asha Therese during Poet’s Day celebration conducted by the English department. Our project spanned from August 2021 to March 2022. The experience of mentoring our participants and compiling an anthology has been blissfully humbling and intellectually satisfying for us.
