

Report on Science Academies' Lecture Workshop on New Vistas in Topology and Analysis 6-8, November 2013 in St Joseph's College Irinjalakuda Kerala

The Science Academies' Lecture Workshop on New Vistas in Topology and Analysis was conducted during 6-8, November 2013 in St Joseph's College Irinjalakuda Kerala. The Inaugural function was arranged at 9.30 AM in the College auditorium on 6th November 2013. Dr. A. Ramachandran, Registrar of CUSAT, formally inaugurated the workshop. Principal Dr. Sr. Annie Kuriakose presided, Dr. N.R. Mangalambal, convening faculty offered welcome and Dr. Sr. Lilly P L, Local coordinator expressed the vote of thanks. The third day at 9.15AM, Dr. Ramanujam had one session on Analysis of Differential Equations. After the tea break, the rest of the sessions were taken up by Dr. T. P. Sasikumar


The valedictory function was held at 4.30 PM.
