ACADEMIC REPORT ETHICS IN RESEARCH

ORGANIZED BY DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY & RESEARCH CELL

Department of Zoology and Research Cell at St. Josephs College of Irinjalakuda had organized a webinar on the topic Ethics in Research on 29/12/2020. The guest of honour and the resource person of the day was Prof. Subhash Chandra Khotia, SERB Research fellow at Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi. The program was coordinated by Dr. Gigi Poulose, HOD Department of Zoology and the session was inaugurated by Dr. Anis K. V. Principal, St. Joseph's College, Irinjalakuda.

The session mainly dealt about what is Research, what is Research Ethics and why is it important in Research. He explained that ethics is a set of principles of behavior formulated by human societies to maintain a defined social order. Research ethics govern the standards of conduct for scientific researchers. It is important to adhere to ethical principles in order to protect the dignity, rights and welfare of research participants. As such, all research involving human beings should be reviewed by an ethics committee to ensure that the appropriate ethical standards are being upheld. Ethics are broadly the set of rules, written and unwritten, that governs our expectations of our own and others' behaviour.

Effectively, they set out how we expect others to behave, and why. While there is broad agreement on some ethical values (for example, that murder is bad), there is also wide variation on how exactly these values should be interpreted in practice. He also explained about Authorship, Types of authorships, and Ethical issues for reviewers, editors and publishers doctoral thesis. The facts about research outputs, publishing, and promotion of good journals in India etc. were also discussed in the webinar. After his presentation time for doubt clearance was provided. Several students and teachers asked questions during the session. Dr. Vidya G, Asst. Professor Department of Zoology presented the vote of thanks. The webinar was a great success and E-Certificates were provided to all the participants.
