

College, Pune and did his LLM from University of Bristol, UK and Franklin Pierce Law Centre, USA. He was the Chair Professor for Intellectual Property Rights at the Prestigious University of Pune from 2003 to 2008. He was the first appointee to the IPR-Chair and the youngest for any chair in this country. He received his law degree at ILS Law College, Pune. He stood 2nd in the merit ranking in University of Pune and was awarded the coveted DFID scholarship by the British Government, in recognition for his outstanding academic achievements and to study law in the University of Bristol, England. The University of Bristol is one of the most reputed universities of England with excellence to match the fame of Oxford and Cambridge. His master's course in law enabled him to deepen his knowledge in company law and intellectual property law along with international contracts and European law. He returned to India to work with a corporate law firm for almost a year only to return to the United States to study masters of law. His focus of study was on Intellectual property (IP). He worked in the Atlanta office of Holland & Knight LLP, one of the top most law firms in the US. He returned to India to start his networking and to lay the foundation for his law firm by traveling globally and making alliances internationally and domestically.
