The Post Graduate and Research Department of English had conducted an international workshop on 'Connecting Classic Literature to Life' by Ms Rose Brown (National Board-Certified Teacher, Aurora High School, Aurora, Ohio, USA) on 04-06-2018, in the New Seminar Hall.
