Faculty Exchange Programme on behalf of Xhei Board

The faculty exchange programme was held on Friday, 16th September, 2022 at St. Paul's College, Kalamassery. Jeswin Jose Vithayathil, faculty from Journalism and Mass Communication, St. Joseph's College, Irinjalakuda was the resource person on the topic ROLE OF VIDEO EDITING. Class started at morning 10 and was concluded afternoon 1.30. 32 students were present in the class.

The class began with the fundamentals of basic video and continued with theory followed by introduction of video editing software Adobe Premiere Pro. Then, students were asked to shoot their own footages, around the campus.

Students shared their views about the videography and they shot some angles with a simple storyline. They made a script and prepared shots for a short film of 2 minutes in short notice.

Everyone was back to Computer Lab for further classes about the software and with the footages they taken, the class continued. Basic editing of video were guided first by grouping students into six. Students arranged the videos accordingly in the software.

Editing was done in different methods, editing with the songs, according to the beat i.e. waveform editor, another method was with the voice over as audio file describing the script i.e. documentary format.

Finally, all groups exported their final edited videos into a folder and was exhibited in the smart board and shared the opinions about their first work. All students were not satisfied with the work as they were into it first time. The faculty said his remarks and suggestions for students to improvise their future projects and described the basic visual meaning of angles and the perspective from viewer.
