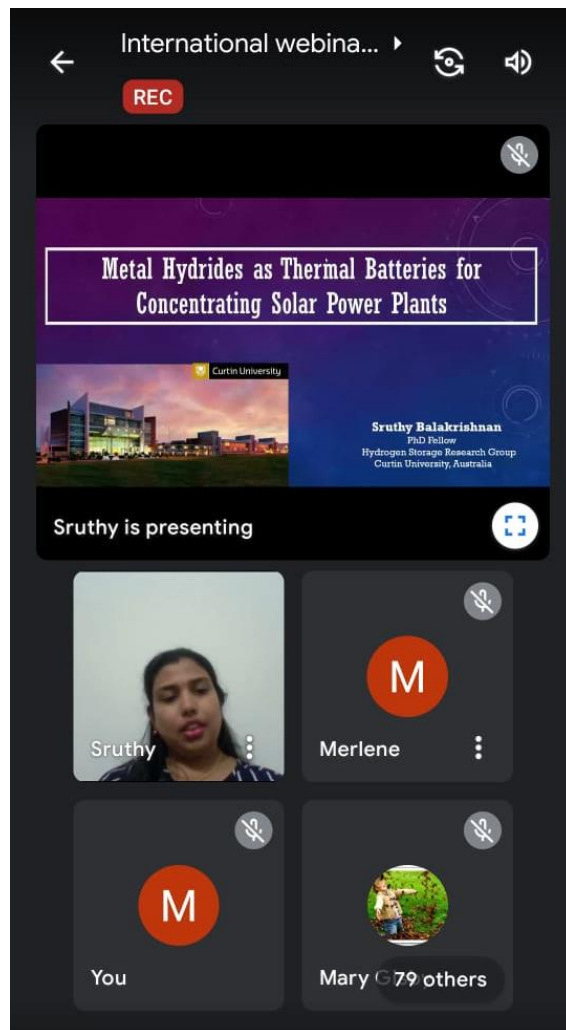
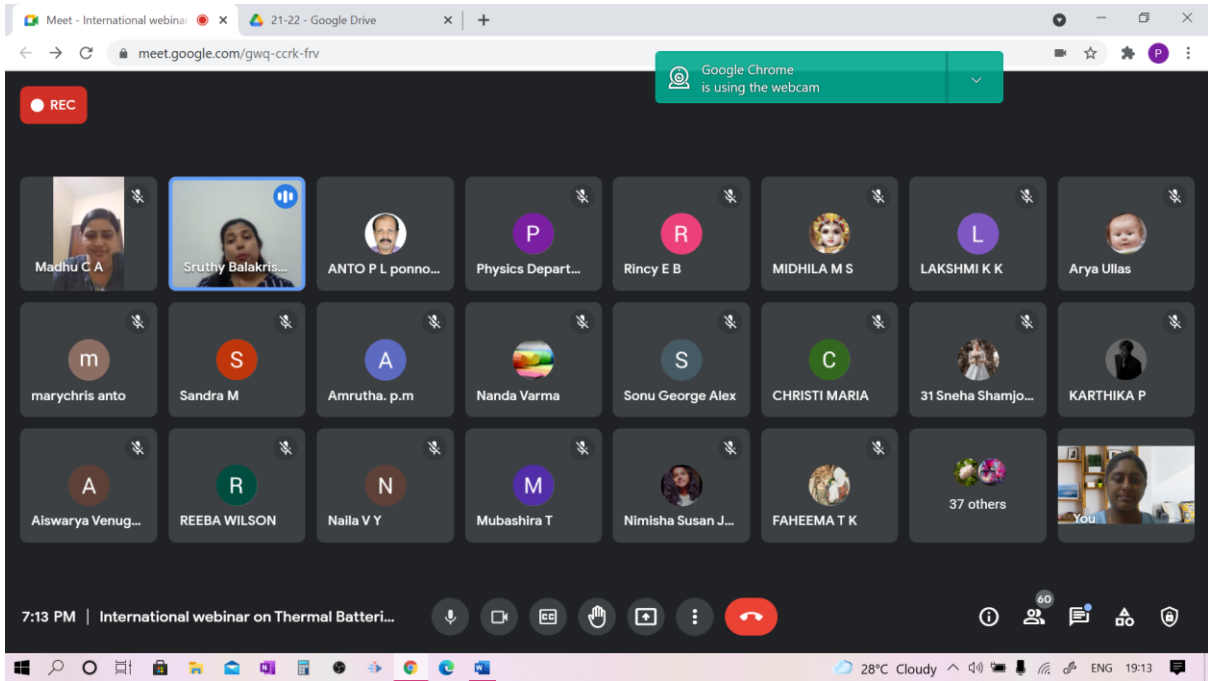
The Department of Physics in association with Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) organized an International Webinar on 'Thermal Batteries for Renewable Energy Storage' on September 17, 2021 at 6 pm through Google meet. The resource person was Ms Sruthy Balakrishnan, PhD Research Fellow at Curtin University, Australia. Being a Curtin Innovation awardee, she was an apt person for webinar.

The talk mainly included two sessions. In the first session, she gave a brief description about her research topic. Aim of her research was to provide continuous energy supply using CSP plants with Thermal battery. She identified the metal hydride named  $\text{CaH}_2$  as a promising solar thermal energy storage material which may lead to clean, cost effective, low carbon alternative to fossil fuels.

In the second session she shared her thoughts, passion and efforts she had undergone for pursuing a PhD and which finally led her to Curtin University to help her achieve her goal. She also shared her experiences she had undergone while doing her research. She discussed about the carrier opportunities available after completing the research.

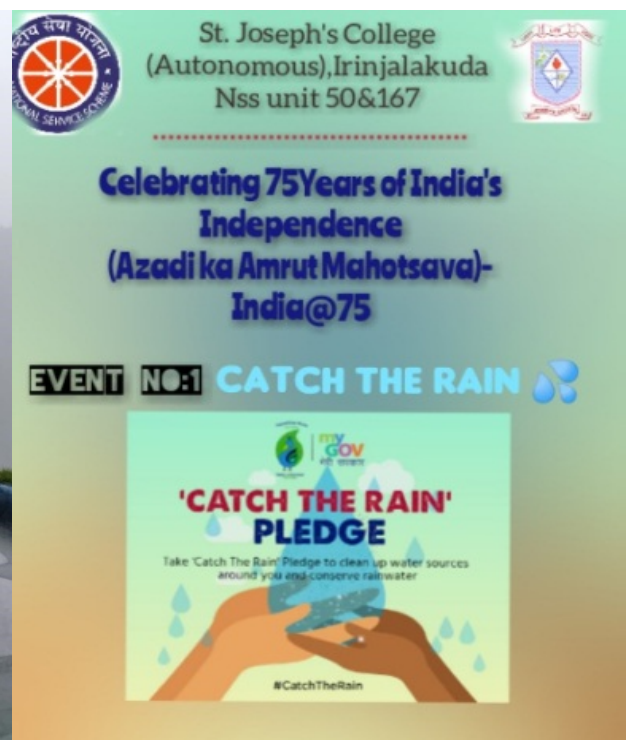

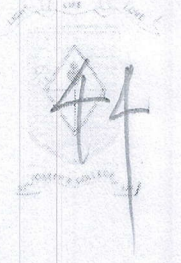


