


1. Restituto Ecosystem 2021




3. National Reading Day

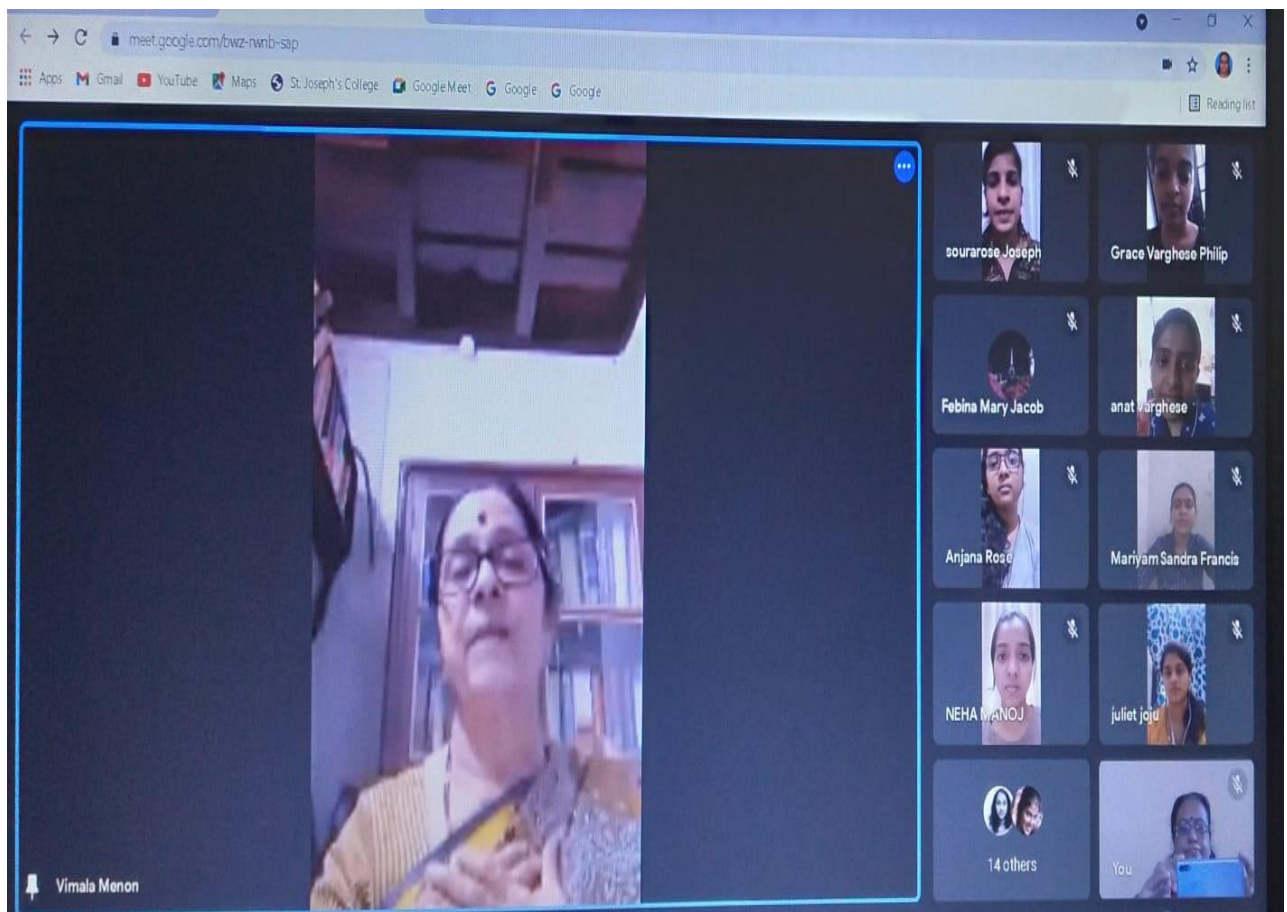


4. Invited lecture Series-I-The Challenges of Translating Literature

8. **Faculty and Students Funded Projects** : Three faculty projects and two students projects funded by the management were awarded this year to the department of English. **GLOWE-English for Empowerment** is an innovative management funded student initiative of the department of English that aims at empowerment of women through English language. The principal investigator of the project is Ms Divya Jobi, second year M A English language and Literature student of the department. GLOWE stands for a Group of Linguistically live and practically Oriented Women of right reasoning. The major project initiatives are Language Guide-to impart language guidance, E4-a specialized training to improve the four basic language skills, Ted Speak to provide training in public speaking skills, Me Magazine- An E- Magazine for publishing students' original works and Webpals- a website to bring out the creative ideas of students. The official launch of the project was held on 12th August 2021 on virtual platform.. Dr Radha Muraleedharan, former Head of the department of English, St Joseph's College, Irinjalakuda launched the project. Dr Sr Asha, Principal, St Joseph's College, Irinjalakuda delivered the benedictory address and Mr Ram C Menon, Director, Public Relations Council of India and Young Communicators' Club Kerala Chapter delivered felicitation speech. Third UG Botany and Second UG English students were given language training as part of this project. The second UG students funded project **Supervivients** focusses on empowering women through entrepreneurship. There are maily four activites under this project- creating brochures and certificates for online events, selling gooseberry juice, production of cakes and cookies and sales of arts and craft products. **Legare- A Cultural Heritage Digitization Initiative** is an academic extension project of the Research and Post Graduate Department of English. The principal investigators of the project are Ms Linet Sebastian and Ms sameena Thomas, Assistant Professors of the department of English. It aims at the research and digital documentation of the local cultural inheritances of Irinjalakuda to help in the preservation of cultural memory, diversity and social integration of the region.It also intends to create a digital database with online access for the public to the cultural diversity of Irinjalakuda. The official launch of the project was held on 13th August 2021. The programme was inaugurated by the Principal of the college, Dr Sr Asha. The chief guest and keynote speaker of the day was Dr Sreevidhya Vattarambath, Assistant Professor, department of History, Government College, Malappuram. She spoke on the historical and

cultural significance of Irinjalakuda. Ms Linet Sebastian and Ms Sameena Thomas are the principal investigators of the project. **Harnessing Online English Education to promote Social Skills and Inculcate Core Values of Nationalism and Environmental Conservation among College Students** is a management funded faculty project aimed at value addition through rethinking and re-inventing curriculum content at the undergraduate level. Ms Anju Susan George and MS Anju Antony, Assistant Professors of the department of English are the principal investigators. The third faculty project titled **Impact of blended Learning in English Language Acquisition: A Study among the undergraduate Students of Selected Colleges in Thrissur District** attempts to examine the impact of blended learning in English language acquisition of first generation higher education learners of online education. Ms Deepa Roy Assistant Professor of the department of English is the principal investigator.
