Feedback

- Feedback from the students pointed on the checking the existing syllabus and its relevance in the domain of study. The students suggested in a thorough analysis of the syllabus based on its employability and enhancement of skill.
- Media has emerged as a wave of rapidly changing currents with a scope of innumerable vocation. To stay updated with the recent areas of study, the alumnae suggested in including more programmes. It was recommended that job-oriented sessions would inspire the students to prepare prior to the work culture and help them choose the job most suitable for them.
- The teachers suggested in organizing personality grooming sessions for helping the students boost their self-esteem and self confidence, which would be supportive in maintaining a positive in their future endeavors.
- Maintenance of balance between academics and practical skills is a major criteria in the designed curriculum. Focusing this objective, the teachers suggested in organizing additional sessions for enhancing the students' practical knowledge in the field of study
- As an orientation of basic skills and for the enhancement of student activities, the employers suggested in the incorporation of a Certificate Course.

Actions taken

Feedback

- The teachers suggested in the change of 2016-17 syllabus and redesign the course content based on the students' ease of understanding. The teachers proposed in the removal of unnecessary and repetitive modules and replace them with novel area of studies like electronic journalism, aesthetic communication or feminist journalism.
- In the feedback received, the students suggested in the inclusion of courses and sessions that could elevate their practical skills required for the field of studies. It was proposed to incorporate sessions on photography, reporting and editing that could be advantageous in the gaining expertise and experience prior to their employment.
- The teachers suggested in the revision of International Communication paper with respect to the emerging trends and opportunities. As per the suggestion the re-designing of the paper could be based on encompassing the social, cultural, political and economic aspects.
- The alumnae emphasized on the practical sessions and suggested in the inclusion of practical based modules into the syllabus.

Feedback

- Students' feedback commended on the existing syllabus for its innovative and relevant portions.
 However, there was a suggestion to modify the paper 'Media culture and society'. It was suggested to omit the excess and repetitive modules for the students' ease of studying.
- The alumnae suggested in the implementation of a course that allows the students be recognize
 the significance of media in nation building. According to the alumnae's feedback a course
 detailing the function of media was necessary and the contents explaining its role as a bridge
 between the government and public was mandatory.

Feedback

- Feedback on the existing syllabus was collected from the stakeholders. The stakeholders
 appreciated on the course contents and expressed their satisfaction. Nevertheless the

 Communication. The teaching faculty suggested in the addition of certain topics that have
 surfaced lately.
- The students expressed their concern at the continuity of the classes during the pandemic scenario. The students suggested in continuing their classes via online mode and sought for a solution for the same.
- The parents suggested that the students should be directed to countless possibilities on online education which offers innovative courses. The parents recommended for an orientation session that could assist the students to find and enroll for informative lessons.
